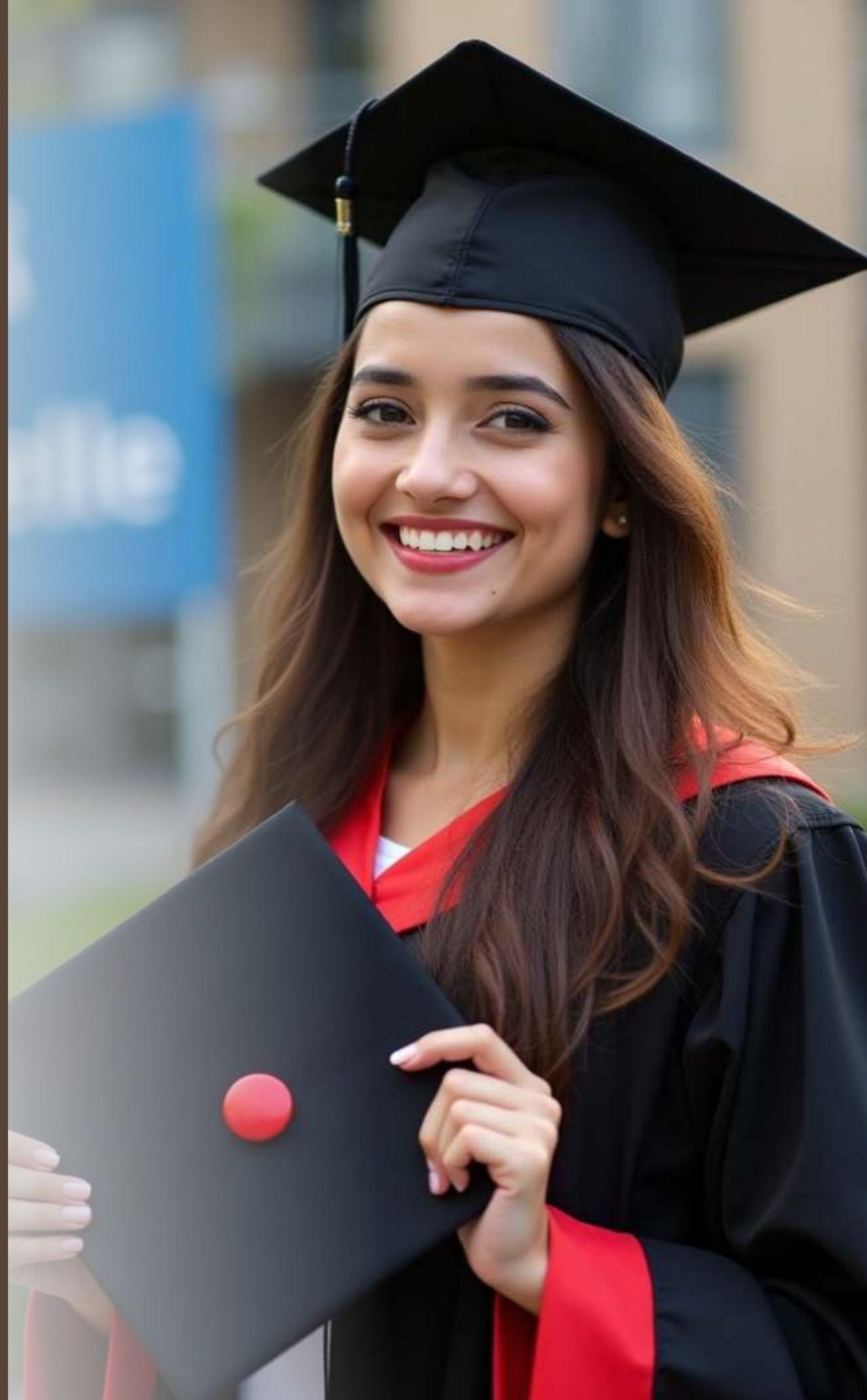

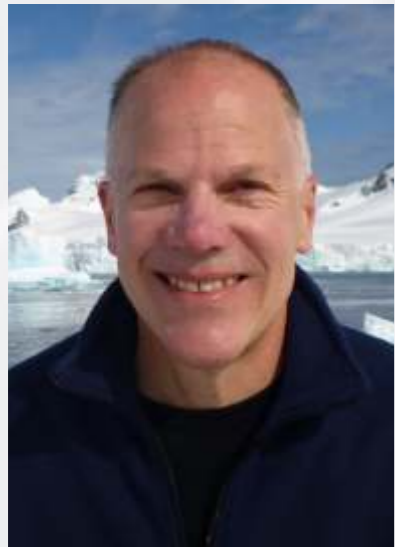

Common Entrance Test

India's Prestigious Scholarship and National-level Entrance Test



For the Academic Year 2026

Chandigarh University Common Entrance Test (CUCET) is a national-level, merit-based scholarship-cum-entrance exam that is mandatory for admission to Engineering, MBA, Pharmacy, MCA, MPT, M.N&D, M.Opto, M.MLS (CB/CM), B.Psy, LLM, and Integrated Law Programs at Chandigarh University. CUCET, offering scholarships worth 200 crore, also presents a significant opportunity for students across all programs to secure up to a 100% scholarship for their higher education.

Eligibility for Appearing in CUCET

For UG courses, a student who has scored 50% or more marks in their secondary education (10+2) or a student appearing for secondary education (10+2) from a recognised board (CBSE/PSEB/ICSE or any other recognised state/national board). For PG courses, a student who has scored 50% or more marks in their graduation from a recognised university.

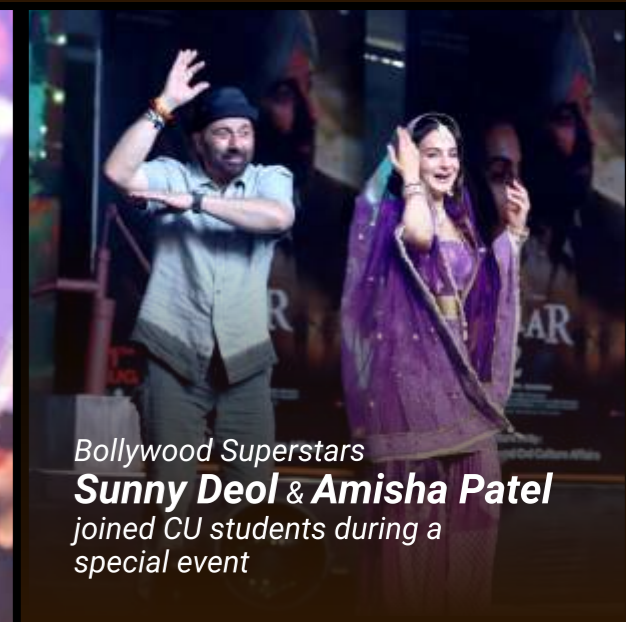
